Where tune submissions are required, solo competitors who do not submit their tunes by the entry deadline shall receive their chosen tune at the adjudicator's table.

Entries including full payment and tune names (for Open Piping Piobaireachd, Open Snare Drumming events, and all band events) must be received by May 30, 2015 for entry to be accepted.

The Open grade is the highest calibre grade of the music discipline.

<u>Step 1</u>: Competitors must enter events on-line and pay by credit card at www.bcpipers.org. No paper entries or cheques will be accepted. If you do not have a credit card, you may use a Visa® Gift Card purchased at any of the following locations. In Canada: RBC Royal Bank, Vancity credit unions, Shoppers Drug Mart, Pharmasave, 7-Eleven, and other retail outlets. In the USA: Wells Fargo, PNC Bank, US Bank, and other retail outlets.

<u>Step 4</u>: Where tune submissions are required, <u>(Open Piping, Open Snare Drumming, and Bands)</u>, tunes must be entered online or submitted to <u>entries@bcpipers.org</u> before the entry deadline of May 30, 2015.

<u>Step 5</u>: Before the entry deadline, updated band rosters must be submitted to the Membership Chair at membership@bcpipers.org

NON-MEMBER FEE

* Solo competitors and bands who are not current members of the BC Pipers Association (BCPA) or an officially recognized piping/pipe band association affiliated with the BCPA (associations in the Alliance of North American Pipe Band Associations), must pay an additional \$4.50 CDN (\$4.50 US) per solo event or \$60 CDN (\$60 US) per band to entry fee total. Non-BCPA members, please submit a picture or scan of your current membership card, or similar proof, to entries@bcpipers.org

VENUE

Percy Perry Stadium on Pinetree Way, Coquitlam (North on Hwy 7 to Pinetree Way. North on Pinetree Way, cross Guildford Way, stadium is 300 m beyond on the right). Gates open at 7:30 am.

SCHEDULE

Solo competitions begin at 8:30 am. Pipe Band competitions begin at 1:00 pm. Massed Bands are DIRECTLY after the Grade 1 competition.

Depending on the number of entries, events may start earlier. All events subject to time change.

Admission tickets for solo competitors and bands will be delivered to their band representative. Solo competitors who are not a member of a band competing at the BC Highland Games should pick up their admission ticket at the WILL CALL booth at the NORTH entrance to the Stadium before 10 am

The number of passes for band members will be based on the player roster officially registered with the BCPA Membership Chair

(membership@bcpipers.org) as of May 30, 2015. Competitors who do not present an admission ticket will have to pay admission, which is not refundable.

General admission tickets (for people who are not solo competitors or performing band members) can be pre-ordered at www.bchighlandgames.com AT THE GATE PRICING IS \$2 HIGHER.

RULES

Events in solo piping, solo drumming, and pipe bands are conducted under the rules of the BC Pipers Association.

All bands are required to perform in Massed Bands to be eligible for prize monies. Marching & Deportment will be judged during band contests.

ORDER OF PLAY

Orders of play for Open Piping, Snare, and Tenor Drumming, and Bands will be determined by random draw. The random draw will take place at 7 pm June 2 at the Competition Secretary's address. All other events are *first to enter*, *last to play*, however all "early bird" entries received by 11:59 pm April 30 will be considered to be randomly received on April 30.

All orders of play will be posted by June 13 on the BCPA web site (www.bcpipers.org) and at 8 am at the Competition Secretary's area on Games day.

Competitors not ready to play in the posted order may be disqualified.

TUNE SELECTION

Tune selection for solo events conducted by the judge at time competitor presents to perform, except for Open Piobaireachd (in final tuning room) and Open Snare Drumming (at 8 am on competition day). For band events, selection of MSR (Grades 1 & 2) will be conducted by Chief Steward when band is at the starting line.

OPEN PIOBAIREACHD

The Open Piobaireachd event will be held on Friday June 19 starting at 5:30 pm, at Simon Fraser University, Burnaby Campus, Academic Quadrangle Room TBA. Please check www.bcpipers.org for further details.

PRIZES

For solo events other than Open, prizes are medals. For solo Open and Band events, monetary prizes are awarded. The aggregate winner in each grade receives a perpetual trophy.

For Open solo events, the total purse for Open Piping is over \$1,300, for Open Snare Drumming is over \$700, and for Open Tenor Drumming is over \$700.

The aggregate winners of the Open Piping, Open Snare Drumming, and Open Tenor Drumming will each receive a special Simon Fraser University 50th Anniversary cash award that, as an example, would raise their total winnings to \$1200, \$800, and \$800 respectively in the event of winning firsts in all events. Ties for the aggregate winner special cash award shall be broken by Piobaireachd preference, then March, Strathspey & Reel preference. The aggregate winners

must appear on the main stage during the awards ceremony to receive their prize money and perpetual trophy from the Games Chieftain.

For band events, the total purse is over \$6.900. The value of prizes will be provided on written request of the Competition Secretary.
