Where tune submissions are required, solo competitors who do not submit their tunes by the entry deadline shall receive their chosen tune at the adjudicator's table.

Entries including full payment and tune names (for Open Snare Drumming events, and all band events) must be received by June 20, 2015 for entry to be accepted.

The Open grade is the highest calibre grade of the music discipline.

GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Step 1</u>: Competitors must enter events on-line and pay by credit card at www.bcpipers.org. No paper entries or cheques will be accepted. If you do not have a credit card, you may use a Visa® Gift Card purchased at any of the following locations. In Canada: RBC Royal Bank, Vancity credit unions, Shoppers Drug Mart, Pharmasave, 7-Eleven, and other retail outlets. In the USA: Wells Fargo, PNC Bank, US Bank, and other retail outlets.

<u>Step 3</u>:. Complete all fields of the competitor information section online. Your BCPA Membership # is on your membership card.

<u>Step 4</u>: Where tune submissions are required, (<u>Open Snare Drumming and Bands</u>), tunes must be entered online or submitted to <u>entries@bcpipers.org</u> before the entry deadline of June 20, 2015.

<u>Step 5</u>: Before the entry deadline, updated band rosters must be submitted to the Membership Chair at membership@bcpipers.org

NON-MEMBER FEE

* Solo competitors and bands who are not current members of the BC Pipers Association (BCPA) or an officially recognized piping/pipe band association affiliated with the BCPA (associations in the Alliance of North American Pipe Band Associations), must pay an additional \$4.50 CDN (\$4.50 US) per solo event or \$60 CDN (\$60 US) per band to entry fee total. VENUE

Albert McGowan Park, 2025 Summit Drive, Kamloops, BC. Gates open at 7:30 am (General Public) and Competitor Numbers will be available at 8:00 am.

SCHEDULE

Solo competitions begin at 8:30 am. Opening Ceremonies at 12:45 pm. Pipe Band competitions begin at approximately 2 pm. Closing Ceremonies and Massed Bands are directly after the final band event (approximately 4:30 pm).

Depending on the number of entries, events may start earlier. All events subject to time change.

Admission tickets for solo competitors and bands will be delivered to their band representative. Solo competitors who are not a member of a band competing at the Kamloops Highland Games should pick up their admission ticket at the WILL CALL booth at the entrance to the Park.

The number of passes for band members will be based on the player roster officially registered with the BCPA Membership Chair

(membership@bcpipers.org) as of June 20, 2015. Competitors who do not present an admission ticket will have to pay admission, which is not refundable.

RULES

Kamloops Highland Games events in solo piping, solo drumming, and pipe bands are conducted under the rules of the BC Pipers Association.

CHALLENGING UP

Pipe Bands may challenge up one grade only if indicated at time of entry and if time permits. Bands desiring to challenge up must enter for all the band events in their regular grade and the event(s) they are challenging up. Prize money for only one grade will be awarded (whichever is highest).

ORDER OF PLAY

Orders of play for Open Piping, Snare, and Tenor Drumming, and Bands will be determined by random draw. The random draw will take place at 7 pm June 23 at the Kamloops Highland Games Competition Secretary's address. All other events are *first to enter, last to play*, however all "early bird" entries received by 11:59 pm May 15 will be considered to be randomly received on May 15.

All orders of play will be posted by July 4 on the Events section of the BC Pipers' Association web site (www.bcpipers.org) and at 8 am at the Competition Secretary's area on Games day. Competitors not ready to play in the posted order may be disqualified.

TUNE SELECTION

Tune selection for solo events conducted by the judge at time competitor presents to perform, except for Open Snare Drumming (at 8 am on competition day). For band events, selection of MSR (Grades 1 & 2) will be conducted by Chief Steward when band is at the starting line.

PRIZES

For solo events other than Open, prizes are medals. For solo Open and Band events, monetary prizes are awarded. The aggregate winner in each grade receives a perpetual trophy.

For Open solo events, the total purse for Open Piping is over \$600, for Open Snare Drumming is over \$400, and for Open Tenor Drumming is over \$200. For band events, the total purse is over \$5,250. The value of prizes will be provided on written request of the Competition Secretary.

All bands are required to perform in Closing Massed Bands to be eligible for prize monies.
